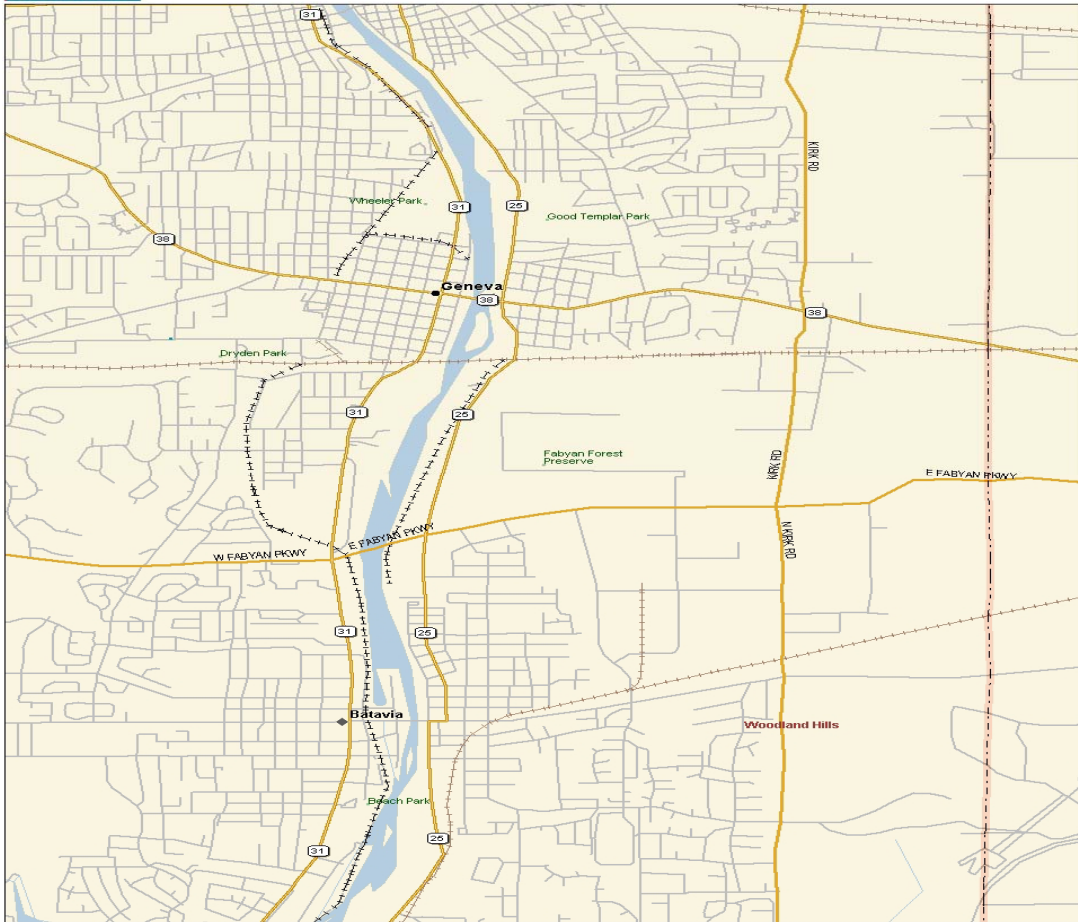
Beginners thru Master Carvers

Demonstrations all day, everyday

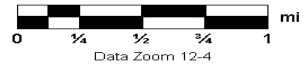
Beginners thru Masters are invited and encouraged to sit at one of our tables and demonstrate leather carving, or seek help from other carvers, or just sit around and “talk leather”

This is an open show and anyone is eligible to enter an exhibit. There is a \$.25 entry fee for each article. 2. Entries will be judged on the basis of originality, use of tools, assembly technique, workmanship. Each article will be judged on each phase of work applied to it. 3. TWO entries per class per person. 4. Entries must be the sole work of the person entering, and must have been completed within 2 years (since August 1, 2003). 5. Entry forms must be postmarked no later than Friday, July 15, 2005 to be accepted. Entries must be received not later than July 29, 2005, with entry tags attached. Entries brought in person will be accepted not later than 11:00 a.m., August 1st (Monday). A container prepared for return must be provided for entries that are to be shipped back to entrant. NOTE: PLEASE INCLUDE RETURN POSTAGE WITH ENTRY FORM. ALSO, INCLUDE SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS. THIS APPLIES TO ENTRIES MAILED IN AND ALSO BROUGHT IN, IN PERSON 6. A packing list MUST accompany all entries. 7. All entries must remain on exhibit until 9:00 P.M., Sunday, August 7, 2005. 8. Exhibitors may pick up their entries on Monday, August 8, 2005 between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon. 9. The Fair Management will use diligence to ensure the safety of entries after their arrival but in no case can the Association be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
