Create Your Own Personalized Christmas Card



Instructions

Here is a great idea for hand-crafted Christmas Cards. This one was made from a piece of 4/5 oz. tooling leather, because when folded it will fit nicely into a ordinary business size envelope.

For best results, it is a good idea to use wide clear packing tape on the back to prevent stretch while tooling.

This card was tooled using a swivel knife with a 1/4" tapered blade, stamping tools #F991 and #S705 for the wreath, small bevelers for the ribbon and a fine modeling tool on the words. The border was #PD011.

The coloring was done with a reduced red for the ribbon and seeds, reduced kelly green for the leaves and reduced light brown for the words. All Fiebing Spirit Dye.

The finish was one application of RTC finish for a resist. After the RTC has been allowed to dry thoroughly an application of medium brown Fiebing's Acrylic Antique Stain was applied.

Gouge a line down the center of the inside for a fold line. Dampen the fold line slightly and fold into shape. Allow to dry.

Finally, prepare an inside page on your computer and personalize your message.
